



SUFFOLK SHEEP SOCIETY 2020 VIRTUAL SHOW

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 8th MAY 2020

- 1 This competition is open to all fully paid up members of the Society and there is no entry fee.
- 2 Only 1 entry per class permitted
- 3 The closing date for entries is the 8th May, class winners will then be included in an on line vote for the '2020 Virtual Breed Champion'
- 4 All eligible entries will be displayed on the Society Website from the 15th May and winners will be announced within 10 days. The online vote for the Breed Champion will be from 25th -29th May with the Champion announced on Monday 1st June.
- 5 Ewe lambs and ram lambs must be birth notified, Shearling ewes and aged ewes must be registered.
- 6 A **maximum of 3 photographs** per class (must include a portrait type photo and a rear/gigot view photo). The third photo can be any of your choice, perhaps a head shot.
- 7 All photographs **MUST** be clearly labelled either with the ear tag number or attached in an email with images of no other sheep and the Society ear tag number in the email Subject Box
- 8 Videos will not be accepted
- 9 It is up to the discretion of the breeder as to what extent sheep are dressed.
- 10 Canvassing will result in disqualification
- 11 Judges can enter classes they are not judging
- 12 Out of focus photographs will not be considered.

13 Entries will be anonymised before forwarding to judges, this may include cropping and pixilating images to conceal the identity of handlers.

14 The judges decision is final and will be based on the images submitted.

15 Prizes of Suffolk Society merchandise will be awarded for the top 10 places in each class.

HOW TO ENTER

- 1 Send three photographs of your entry to enquiries@suffolksheep.org ensuring that Suffolk Virtual Show Entry is in the 'Subject' box. **EACH ENTRY REQUIRES A SEPARATE EMAIL**
- 2 Clearly state in the email, your prefix, class and ear tag number for the sheep entered along with a contact mobile/telephone number.
- 3 If possible, photographs **SHOULD** be clearly labelled with the ear tag number. If this is not possible, please ensure the ear tag number is included in email text.
