Any sheep considered to be of good conformation but marginal in the mouth will be marked with a red spot on the shoulder and the fault intimated to the auctioneer by the Exhibitor and announced at the time of sale. Buyers are encouraged to also inspect the sheep as well. All sheep will be sold in guineas and subject to the conditions of sale of the Suffolk Sheep Society and to the Auctioneers General Conditions of Sale. All Suffolk Rams and Ram Lambs are warranted and MV Accredited.

Sellers will be provided with plastic tags with the Lot Number printed on it. The Lot Number needs to correspond to the EID Tag Number of the Ram on your AML1 form.

No Rams marked with a Red Spot on the Shoulder will be eligible for the Show.

Biosecurity

All visitors must comply with the relevant biosecurity requirements including wearing clean clothing that can be disinfected. Leggings will be needed and there may be extra requirements for handling sheep.

Transport & Licences
