DIRECTIONS TO THE MARKET

From the Heads of the Valleys / Abergavenny Roundabout take the exit signed Usk/Clytha (B4598, old Raglan Road), after approx 3½ miles, ignore turning for Usk, carry on signed Raglan, the entrance to Monmouthshire Livestock Centre will be found on the right hand side after approx 6 miles (from roundabout).

From Monmouth / Raglan, take the final exit off roundabout signed Clytha, Garden Centre, Golf Course & Livestock Market, the entrance will be on the left after approx 1½ miles.

Rules for exhibitors

1. Exhibitors wishing to arrive on the Friday, please notify Helen Roberts 07976 803066 4th May. The market will be open 4pm – 8pm, please note Lyndon will not be available on the Friday so please ring the market direct Tel: 01291 690962 with any queries.
2. Any livestock left overnight is left at your own risk.
3. Pens will have your name on them.
4. Exhibitors must be aware of and adhere to all DEFRA's current regulations for One Day Shows relating to animals, health schemes, bio security etc.
5. Exhibitors are requested to arrive by 9.30am judging will commence at 10.30am
6. The market would prefer you to use shavings, if using straw please do not use too much. If this rule is abused the Market may charge us for cleaning. Exhibitors to provide their own shavings and straw.
7. Holding number 60 -113-8001. Please remember your Movement licence and MVA Form
8. Judging at 10.30am. White coats must be worn during judging.
9. One competitor per animal allowed in the judging ring while a class is being judged
10. Canteen will be open from 8am to serve breakfast and a limited menu thereafter, it will shut at 3pm on 9th May. It will not be open on the Friday.
